SENG Program Offered February 18 & 19, 2010 Carthage College, TWC Rm 128-C

Here's a valuable opportunity to train as a SENG facilitator. Parents, school psychologists, G/T teachers and social workers are encouraged to participate. The training is free, but there is a fee of \$50 for two required textbooks. **Registration is limited to 25 people.**

The SENG Parent Discussion Group Model is a nationally recognized model for supporting parents of gifted children. SENG is an acronym for the organization Supporting Emotional Needs of the Gifted (www.sengifted.org). WATG is especially pleased to announce that the trainers for this session will be Dr. James Webb, founder of SENG, and Mrs. Arlene DeVries, a professional in gifted education and trainer of SENG model parent facilitators. People trained as SENG Parent Discussion Group Facilitators return to their home area to conduct parent groups at the local level.

This program offers two opportunities. First, **training for facilitators** will be conducted:

February 19, 2010 8:30am-1:00pm

Second, **parents are invited** to register for a parent group discussion about gifted children, led by newly trained facilitators:

February 18, 2010 7-9:00pm

While there is no fee for the parent portion, registration is necessary.
