



Course Options Policy

Resident Students

The Kenosha Unified School District shall accommodate resident students who wish to participate in the Wisconsin Course Options Program. Kenosha eSchool students will follow the Kenosha Unified School District Course Option Policy (6440).

Non-Resident Students

The policy and procedures that will be followed for nonresident students interested in enrolling in Kenosha eSchool courses will be as follows:

The Kenosha eSchool policy and criteria for accepting and rejecting applications under state subsection (3)* from pupils who reside in another school district shall be the same as the policies and criteria for entry into the course that apply to pupils who reside in the school district. The Kenosha Unified School Board and the Kenosha eSchool Governance Board may give preference in enrollment in a course to residents of the Kenosha Unified School district as openings occur.

Procedure

Prior to May 1, the Principal/designee will designate any available seats for Course Options. The number of Course Option seats reported will be used to determine the availability of enrollments in Kenosha eSchool courses for nonresident students for both semesters and the Summer School session of the following school year. Nonresident students applying for available Course Option seats will follow enrollment criteria and consistent with resident students.
