

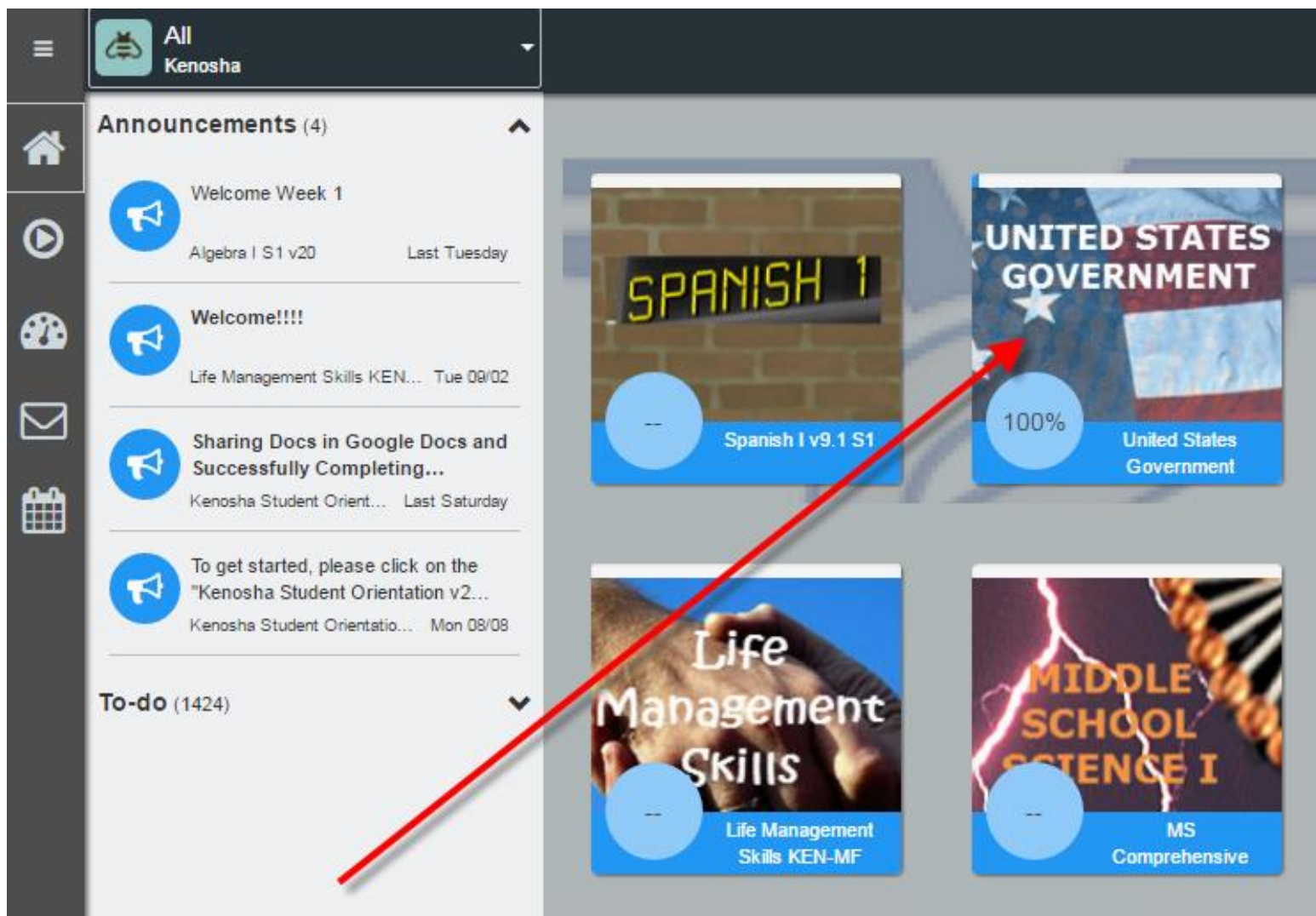
How do I log in? (Grades 6-12)

1. Sign into your eSchool student account using the link under the Course Login tab or by using the direct link: <https://wen.geniussis.com/PublicWelcome.aspx?id=30>
2. Click on a course in the **Academic Snapshot** area of your Genius Dashboard.
