

Wisconsin Civics Exam

All KUSD students are required to pass the civics exam in order to graduate

One of the new KUSD graduation requirements is the successful completion of the WI State Civics Test. This test has been incorporated into the US Government and Politics course (regular and honors versions) for Kenosha eSchool students.

If you are enrolled in the US Government and Politics course, you will schedule this test with your instructor, Sarah Eisenberg. This exam can be administered on the same date and time you take your final exam, or you can set it up to take at a separate time sometime before taking the final exam.
