Dear parents and guardians,

Our school year is off to a great start. We are excited about increasing academic achievement, closing our learning gaps and preparing students for success beyond 4K-12 education. As a learning community, we are dedicated to continually improving Kenosha Unified for all students. One source we use to reflect on our strengths and areas for improvement is the Department of Public Instruction school and district report cards, which are created for every publicly funded school and district in the state.

The report cards are intended to help all schools and districts use data to target improvement efforts to prepare students for the next step, including the next grade level, graduation, college and career. The data collected reflects a score for four main areas:

- Student Achievement proficiency in reading and mathematics on state assessments
- Student Growth measured by year-to-year improvements in achievement
- Closing Gaps in performance between specific student groups (comparing English language learners, lowincome students, students with disabilities and members of a racial or ethnic group with their peers)
- On-track and Post-secondary Readiness measured by reliable predictors of high school graduation and success after high school

Schools and districts also are evaluated on their level of student engagement – test participation rates, attendance rates and dropout rates – when applicable. Based on its score in all areas, a school or district receives one to five stars and one of five rating categories for whether expectations are met.

KUSD's 2015-16 DPI report card results include:

- Overall rating of "meets expectations"
- Overall score increase from 65.9 in 2013-14 to 71.6 in 2015-16
- Increase in each priority area score from 2013-14 to 2015-16
- Largest score increase in Student Growth priority area (57.8 to 70.8)
- Nine schools "significantly exceed expectations" (none in 2013-14)
- 29 of 36 schools increased overall score (16 in 2013-14)
- 24 of 36 schools increased Student Achievement ratings

Many school and district scores across the state changed compared to previous report cards due to changes required by the legislature, including a weighting formula to account for poverty, a new method for calculating student growth and use of Forward Exam data.
