

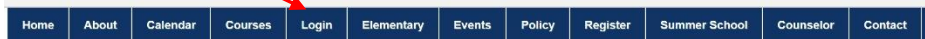
Career & College Planning

- Learn about what majors mean and what colleges across the whole US offer the major

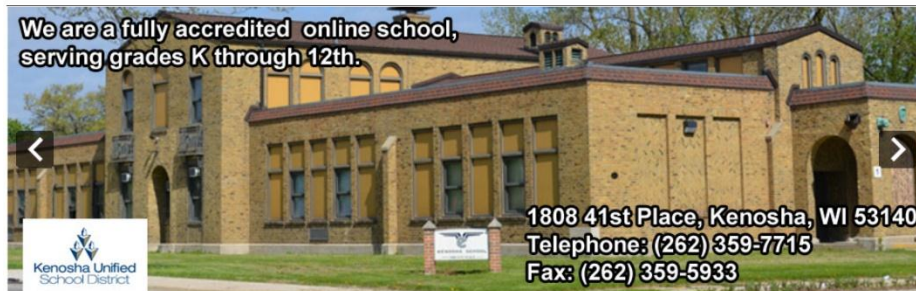
HOW DO I GET STARTED?

- Click on **Login** on the Home page

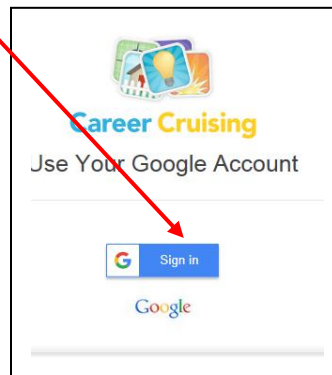
