Dear Parent/Guardians and Students:

The Kenosha eSchool will be administering the “Measures of Academic Progress” (MAP) assessment for all full-time eSchool students’ grades 2-10. All students are required to take this test three times a year. Once in the fall, winter, and spring. The MAP’s test is a computer-adaptive assessment tool that is used in KUSD to monitor student growth and identify academic development over time. The computerized test is required by the District as a “benchmark” assessment.

Students will be tested by grade level at the eSchool building. We are located at 1808 41<sup>st</sup> Place. The test takes approximately two hours to complete, depending on the grade level. If a student needs additional time, we can make arrangements for him/her to come an additional day to do so. Please reference the schedule below to verify the date and time your child should report to the eSchool office:
