Dear Parent/Guardian:

Kenosha Unified School District requires that **all** 11th grade students take the ACT Plus Writing and the ACT WorkKeys in the spring of their junior year. It is important to note that the students can use the ACT Plus Writing test scores for college admissions. The enclosed flyer highlights these two exams, including the breakdown of the content area, what to bring and not bring on testing days, and additional links to reference for more information on the test specifics. **Families must make arrangements for their 11th grade child to be at the eSchool building by 8:30 a.m. on both Tuesday, February 27th and Wednesday, February 28st to complete both the ACT Plus Writing and the ACT WorkKeys tests.**

A required **pre-administration session** that the students must attend will be held on Tuesday, February 20th at 10:30 a.m. This session will last approximately 90 minutes. Students will be filling out their demographics, student profile, interest inventory, and high school course information/grades. Each student is allowed to select up to four colleges they would like their scores sent to. I recommend that students think ahead of time of where they want their scores sent. **If a student does not attend the pre-test session, the State of Wisconsin does NOT allow them to take the tests on February 27th and February 28th.** The schedule is as follows:
