Dear Parent/Guardians and Students:

Kenosha eSchool will be administering the **Wisconsin Forward Exam** on April 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, and 13<sup>th</sup>. The Wisconsin Forward Exam is an assessment that is used to gauge how well students are mastering the Wisconsin State Standards. This test is given to students in grades 3-8 and grade 10. (10<sup>th</sup> graders will be taking this at a later date.) Students will take the Forward Exam online at the eSchool building. It consists of multiple-choice questions, short answer questions, and a writing assessment. Each grade level has specific subject areas that they must complete. (Not all grade levels complete all five subtests.) Please reference the chart below to view the date, time, and subject(s) your child will be completing his/her exams.

Please note that this is not a timed test so students work through and complete tests at different paces. Your child may need more or less time that is scheduled above. It is not unusual for a student to complete a test early or choose to take more than one test on the same day.
