Dear Parent/Guardians and Students:

The Kenosha eSchool will be administering the “**Measures of Academic Progress**” (MAP) assessment for all full-time eSchool students’ grades 2-10, the week of April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2018. **All students are required to take this test three times a year;** once in the fall, winter, and spring. The MAP’s test is a computer-adaptive assessment tool that is used in KUSD to monitor student growth and identify academic development over time. The computerized test is required by the District as a “benchmark” assessment.

10<sup>th</sup> grade students are also required to take the Social Studies subtest for the **Wisconsin Forward Exam**. The Wisconsin Forward Exam is an assessment that is used to gauge how well students are mastering the Wisconsin State Standards. It consists of multiple-choice questions, short answer questions, and a writing assessment. This will be given after they complete the Reading and Math subtests of the MAPS test on the same day. Here is the schedule for 10<sup>th</sup> graders:

Students will be tested at the eSchool building. We are located at 1808 41<sup>st</sup> Place. The three subtests, although they are not timed, take an average of three hours to complete.
