Dear Parent/Guardians and Students:

The Kenosha eSchool will be administering the “Measures of Academic Progress” (MAP) assessment for all full-time eSchool students’ grades 2-10 the week of April 23rd, 2018. **All students are required to take this test three times a year;** once in the fall, winter, and spring. The MAP’s test is a computer-adaptive assessment tool that is used in KUSD to monitor student growth and identify academic development over time. The computerized test is required by the District as a “benchmark” assessment.

Students will be tested by grade level at the eSchool building. We are located at 1808 41st Place. The test takes approximately two hours to complete. Please reference the schedule below to verify the date and time your child should report to the eSchool office:
